

















1. Europe at the time of World War I



- Triple Alliance
- Bismarck who unified the German states formed the Triple Alliance with Italy and Austria-Hungary with the aim of stable development of the unified Germany (1882).

2. Outbreak of World War I




Against the backdrop of heightened tension between Austria-Hungary and Serbia, the then archduke of Austria-Hungary and his wife had been killed by young Serbian assassins in Sarajevo, Bosnia (28 June 1914). Austria-Hungary declared war on Serbia as a consequence, which led to the outbreak of World War I which was later joined by the Central powers and Allied powers.

3. The Versailles System after World War I



 As the result of the Allied powers winning the First World War, Austria-Hungary and the Ottoman Empire collapsed whereas newly independent states have emerged. Hungary is being introduced as one of those newly independent states.

5. Influence of the Russian Revolution




 Hungarian Revolution is being introduced as one of those influenced by the Russian Revolution.

7. The World at the time of World War II




 Hungary is represented as one of the Axis powers in the map which depicts the world at the time of World War II.
