




There is mounting research evidence that technology provides new opportunities for teachers







KOREA'S STATUS

In the latest results, South Korea ranked second in reading (just behind Shanghai, China who participated as a city), fourth in math and sixth in science.










South Korea Vs. United States 2009 PISA Results








- It has all the NCERT textbooks (classes- I to XII) into e-pub 3.0 format.

- The e-contents available on NROER (about 20,000 digital contents) are also available on e-pathshala.










Glimpse of Flipbooks





Impact Factor of EPathshla webportal and mobile App






